Complete your registration

Once you have registered to compete at the LRSEF, be sure to **finalize your registration**. Here is a checklist of the items you need to have completed by **midnight on Monday, February 15, 2016**.

- ✓ Be sure that **all sections of the registration page are filled out**. LRSEF will communicate with you **through lrsef.stemwizard.com**
- ✓ Check the **spelling** of your name(s).
- ✓ **List the Title** of your project as you would like it to be in the program.
- ✓ Type in your **Approved Question**.
- ✓ Fill out **ALL of the Research Plan sections** -be sure to include at least 5 bibliography entries.
- ✓ **Upload ISEF forms 1, 1a and 1b for ALL projects**. Uploads can be done with a scanner or by taking a photograph.
 - High School - Some categories will need additional forms. Run the Rules Wizard as provided on StemWizard to check .
 - Middle School - **only required to have forms 1, 1a and 1b**.
- ✓ Include your **Abstract!**
- ✓ **Files**- if there anything thing else needed for project - add it here.
- ✓ Be sure to **click SAVE and then DONE** once all work complete.
- ✓ Payment of \$10.00 needs to be made by student or school.
