# 2016 Student Important Information, by Ronda Fields Co-Fair Director, LRSEF

# Check-in from 8am- 8:45am

- 1) Check in at the respective table. Pick up name tag, goody bag, project # with location and student handout.
- 2) Take project and belongings to the Safety Check area. Make sure you pick up a safety check receipt. Not Allowed at Project or Booth
  - 1. Living organisms, including plants
  - 2. Soil, sand, rock, cement and/or waste samples, even if permanently encased in a slab of acrylic
  - 3. Taxidermy specimens or parts
  - 4. Preserved vertebrate or invertebrate animals
  - 5. Human or animal food as part of the exhibitor demonstration of the project.
  - 6. Human/animal parts or body fluids (for example, blood, urine)
  - 7. Plant materials (living, dead, or preserved) that are in their raw, unprocessed, or non-manufactured state
  - 8. All chemicals including water (Projects may not use water in any form in a demonstration)
  - 9. All hazardous substances or devices (Example: poisons, drugs, firearms, weapons, ammunition, reloading devices, and lasers)
  - 10. Items that may have contained or been in contact with hazardous chemicals
  - 11. 3-D Printers
  - 12. Dry ice or other sublimating solids
  - 13. Sharp items (for example, syringes, needles, pipettes, knives)
  - 14. Flames or highly flammable materials
  - 15. Batteries with open-top cells or wet cells
  - 16. Glass or glass objects (exception-computer/tablets)

#### Project Set-up: must be complete before 9am

- 3) Go to the assigned gallery and table to begin setting up your project. There will be gallery hosts and helpers on each floor to help you.
  - a. 2<sup>nd</sup> floor Gallery projects-use the main elevator
  - b. 3<sup>rd</sup> floor gallery projects-use the freight elevator

#### **Judging**

All student projects will be judged at least once between 9-11:30 am. If you have not been judged by 10:30 am please alert the gallery host.

There are over 50 Special Awards, so please remain with your projects whenever possible during the morning and afternoon judging sessions.
